



**Tickets for “Time Machine – a musical journey”
Saturday 27th February 2010 7.30 pm Royal Concert Hall**

Parents and friends of NYO can now order tickets for our 25th anniversary concert, travelling through time with some classic pieces at the Royal Concert Hall. **Orders can be placed only up to Thursday 19th February. After this date, tickets must be bought direct from the Royal Concert Hall box office (0115 989 5555).** We strongly recommend that you order tickets in advance in order to ensure that you have the seat in the area you wish, to save yourself the 5% booking fee and to reduce queuing time at the box office on the concert evening.

Celebrate the 25th anniversary year of the NYO with a programme for all the family, journeying back in time to the medieval mysteries of Carmina Burana, the tribulations of Jean Valjean in Les Miserables and the razzmatazz of the Chicago Depression. Then, leaping forwards, travelling Who knows where with the Doctor before returning to George II’s coronation with the choral work, Zadok the Priest to arrive at the finale of the 1812 Overture, which, with its exciting cannon sounds and fireworks, will be certain to create an evening to remember. Please encourage as many of your friends and family to come — especially those who wouldn’t normally think of coming to a “classical” concert.

Please indicate on the attached form whether you would like seats in the centre of the hall, or seats on the right or left-hand side of the arena as you face the stage. So, for example, if you particularly wish to see the cellos, you may wish to choose tickets on the left-hand side of the hall so that you are diagonally opposite them. Members of NYiO, NYtO and NYJO who wish to sit with their family need to order their free tickets on the attached form.

The order form should be posted to Michelle Fischer at Ashcroft, Vicarage Lane, Ruddington, Notts NG11 6HB or handed to Margaret Chadwick at an NYO rehearsal. No forms will be accepted after Friday 19th February. If you wish your tickets to be posted to you, please enclose a stamped, addressed envelope and a cheque made payable to Nottingham Youth Orchestra. **No tickets will be posted unless a cheque and an SAE are provided.** Alternatively, tickets will be given to NYO members or to orchestra administrators (NYiO and NYtO) for distribution at rehearsals in the weeks before the concert.
